In 2007, Classic Bronze, an advanced handbell ringing event, began in Edmonton, Alberta to give advanced ringers an opportunity to make music together in a massed setting. Classic Bronze features advanced level 3/4/5 music and includes advanced ringers capable of reading level 3 and performing level 5 handbell music. Ringers must submit a reference attesting to their skills and musicianship as a handbell ringer, prior to being accepted into Classic Bronze.
